Job Summary

The Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministries organizes and leads the daily operations of ministry for youth and young adults at Our Savior. These include middle school youth, high school youth, college students, and young working professionals. The Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministries is a full-time position.

Job Responsibilities

- Develops and oversees middle and high school youth programs
- Coordinates and leads youth events, such as youth nights, youth gatherings, and mission trips
- Plans and facilitates programming for young adults (working professionals, singles, married, etc.)
- Oversees and supports young adult small groups
- Engages with the school and community to connect youth and young adults with Our Savior
- Trains and oversees volunteer teams for various youth and young adult ministries
- Researches and selects age-appropriate curriculum for youth and young adults
- Prepares materials (equipment, copies, transportation etc.) for youth and young adult events
- Other duties as assigned by the pastors

- Demonstrates a faith in Jesus Christ, and sets a personal example of integrity, discipleship, and evangelism to the Our Savior community
